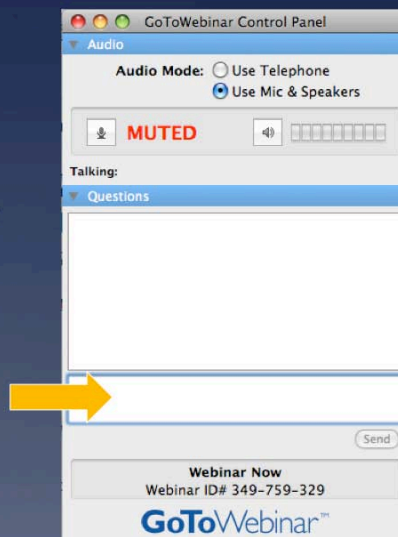
AN ALLIANCE TO SUPPORT LOCAL GOVERNMENT
