San Francisco Bay Area Regional Energy Network (BayREN)


Purpose: Design and implement effective energy savings programs in the nine county Bay Area.

- ✓ Regional Efficiencies
- ✓ Build local capacity
- ✓ Independent of PG&E

Proposed Activities (\$41.6 million)

- Single Family Retrofit: \$18 million
- Multi-family Retrofit: \$9.7 million
- Codes and Standards: \$3.4 million
- Financing for EE Retrofits: \$10.5 million
