

## Why is SLO County Preparing a Climate Action Plan?

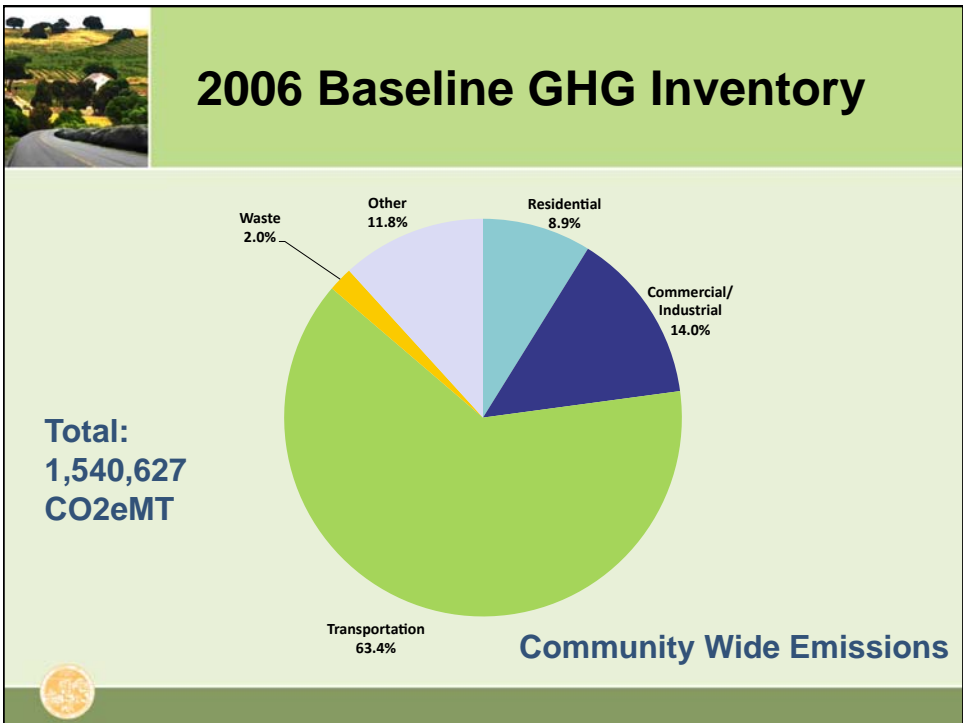
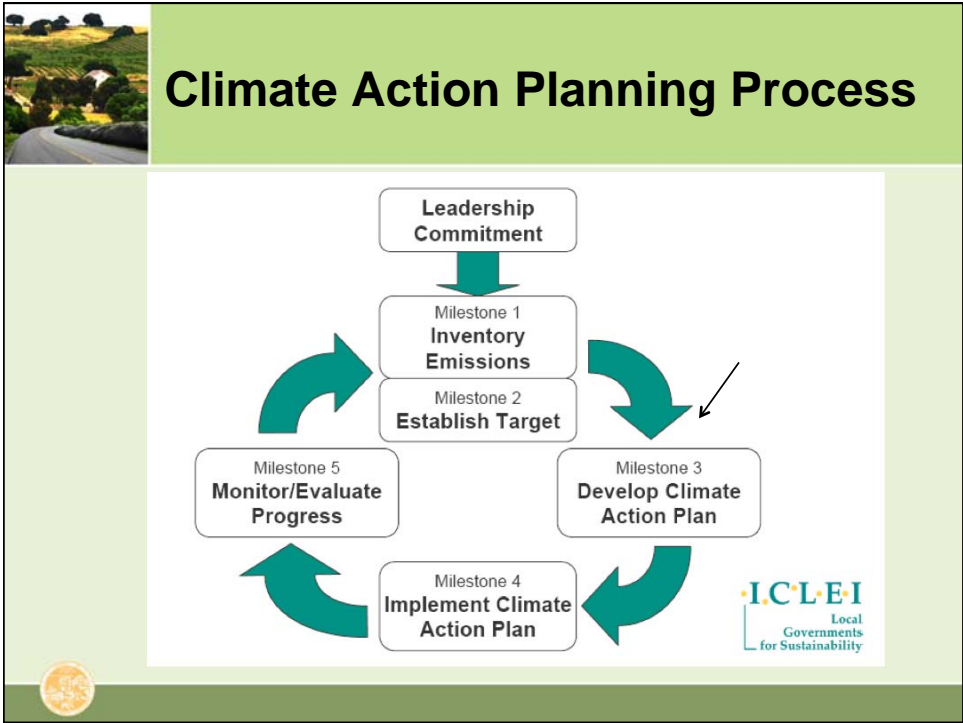
- Comply with AB 32- California's Global Warming Solutions Act

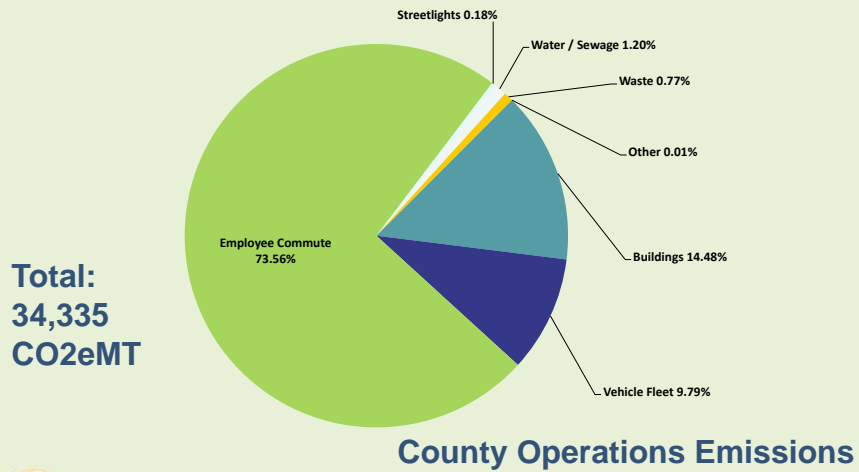

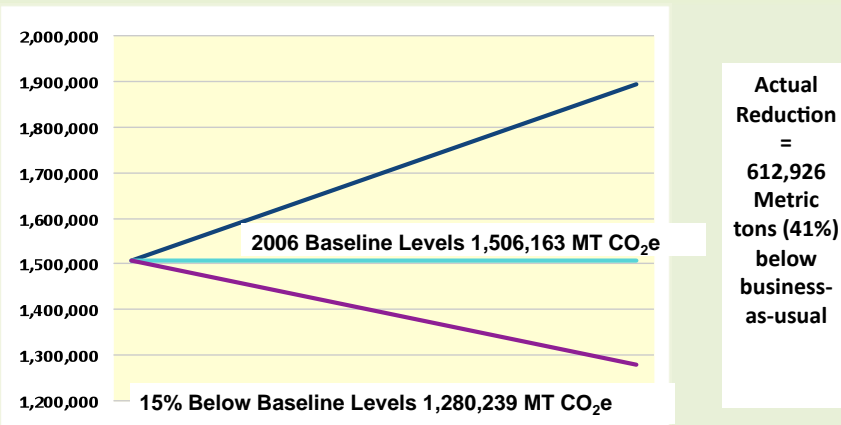




## 2006 Baseline GHG Inventory
